Please be advised that, on behalf of PKF-Mark III, Inc. ("PKF"), we are in receipt of your Notice of Intent to Award dated June 16, 2016 and received in this office on June 20, 2016. We too look forward to working with you on this project.

In response to the same and as directed therein, please note that, as has been addressed on several occasions previously, PKF is a union contractor and has a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the United Steelworkers, AFL-CIO (Local 15024) whose union employees are multi-skilled. The USW Local 15024 maintains a U.S. Department of Labor approved apprentice program. Moreover, as an active member of ABC of Eastern Pennsylvania, PKF also participates in the ABC Apprenticeship Program. PKF has been in periodic communication with the Borough and/or its Solicitor on this matter for almost one (1) year and in that time, PKF has previously provided copies of the USW Apprenticeship Certificate of Registration with the U.S. Department of Labor, ABC of Eastern Pennsylvania Apprenticeship Certificate of Registration and a copy of PKF's Certificate of Membership in the ABC. In this regard, I have included copies of the same herein for your review.

Please further be advised that PKF intends to self-perform the vast majority of the work. At this time, PKF has not determined what work, if any, will be subcontracted. However, it has been determined that PKF will not enter into any subcontracts with a value of \$75,000.00 or more. Accordingly, PKF has not included any Bidder Qualification Statements and/or Apprenticeship Verification documents as noted in your correspondence.


Finally, be advised that PKF is in receipt of the Notice of Protest filed by the second low bidder and will respond to the same via separate correspondence.

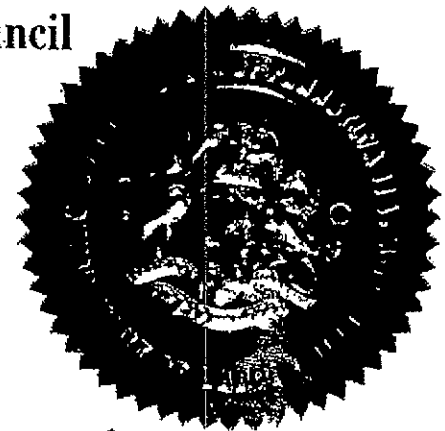
